Concealed Carry on the Grounds

After another lively Board meeting, the following policies are being adopted at DBCL:

When Wisconsin's concealed carry law goes into effect, concealed carry and holsters will be allowed on most parts of the grounds for those with a WISCONSIN CONCEALED CARRY PERMIT. An exception will be the Scout Grounds. Loaded firearms will NOT be allowed in the clubhouse as alcohol is served there. Third party concealed carry classes conducted at the club grounds are being discussed. Attorneys, WIFORCE and others familiar with liability issues and course content and costs are being consulted before a decision is made on how or if, to conduct these classes.

Short Range Construction and Other Grounds Improvements

There have been delays in getting the drawings done for the short range and it is running behind schedule. The drainage and wall repairs on the east side of the clubhouse are being planned. The wind damage to our tenant's barn and stable has been turned over to the insurance company. Two air conditioners approved for installation in the basement plus stone for the driveway at the scout grounds and the 200 yard pit road have been ordered. I have asked in this column that Construction Engineers, Architects and Tradesmen come forward to help with this and other projects. So far 7 out of 1,400+ members have

answered the call - a whopping .5%. It's difficult to keep dues low and complete jobs with volunteers when no one can help. The other alternative is to pay much more and hire professionals do all facets of these projects. It's your club and ultimately your choice as to how these projects proceed. Thanks to Nathan, Ron, Jim, Dick, Joey, Doug and Steve for offering a hand. You know who you are.
