I hope everyone had a wonderful holiday season. Its time to start thinking of the 2012 SCTP/AIM season. On Saturday February 11th at 9:00 AM at the Daniel Boone club house main hall, we will have our sign up meeting. At this time we will talk about the upcoming season and get everyone registered.

The Scholastic Clay Target program in Wisconsin consists of three divisions starting in middle school thru high school to the age of 18 and still in high school. The AIM program also has a division for young adults that are 18 to 23 and in college and a division for young adults that are 18 to 20 and pursuing a career path that does not include full-time school. We would like to see that all the youth have taken a safety program like the hunter safety program and are very familiar with the shotgun they will be using. If you have questions do not hesitate
