The work will be hard but the results should be incredible. Let's see 80 to 100 workers so the load is lightened for everyone. Ranges will be closed until the work is done. Bring tools, shovels and rakes.

RUNNING DEER #1

Your Board is debating what, if anything should be done with the crumbling walls at Running Deer #1 on the Auxiliary Range. Options include: Replacing the wall and sinking floor of the blockhouse with a new poured wall and slab like at the 200 yard range, a new block wall and repair of the floor, rip out the old wall and simply put up a dirt berm, do a temporary fix by patching the old wall or just let it continue to crumble. What is your input?

7 TO 10 YARD RANGE CONSTRUCTION

Your Board has been researching ways to expand and improve the 7 and 10 yard handgun range. The consensus is to construct a separate range on the north side of the current 50 meter range which can function independently from the 50 and the 200. It will have side walls and an improved roof for added safety. While pricey, more and more DBCL shooters are using the existing targets and your Board feels the added points and safety will be well worth the cost. Be ready to vote on the design and budget at the May or June meeting.

Important Safety Concern – Please disarm trap machines before entering the trap house.

There have been times when we have entered the houses and they are still armed – this can be a very painful experience for the next person to go in front of the house if it accidentally trips and sends out a bird.



Trap and Skeet leagues have started and the turn out has been great. You can shoot from 5:00 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. either Wednesday or Thursday night. You can shoot ahead a maximum of four weeks, but you cannot fall behind. So please, get there early for registration and get you scores in.

Practice All Year – All members can be checked out on our equipment. This can be done on trap and skeet nights or by appointment. Once you are certified and have your card stamped, you can use the machines when the club is open and no league or special events are taking place. If you use our machines, remember you must purchase the clay birds from the caretakers for \$12.00 per box. Do not place any “pick-ups” in the machines. If you have any problems, let the caretakers or any member of the Trap and Skeet Committee know. Please clean up after yourself. Shoot safe and have fun!

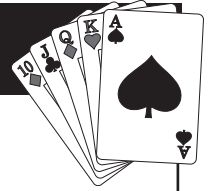

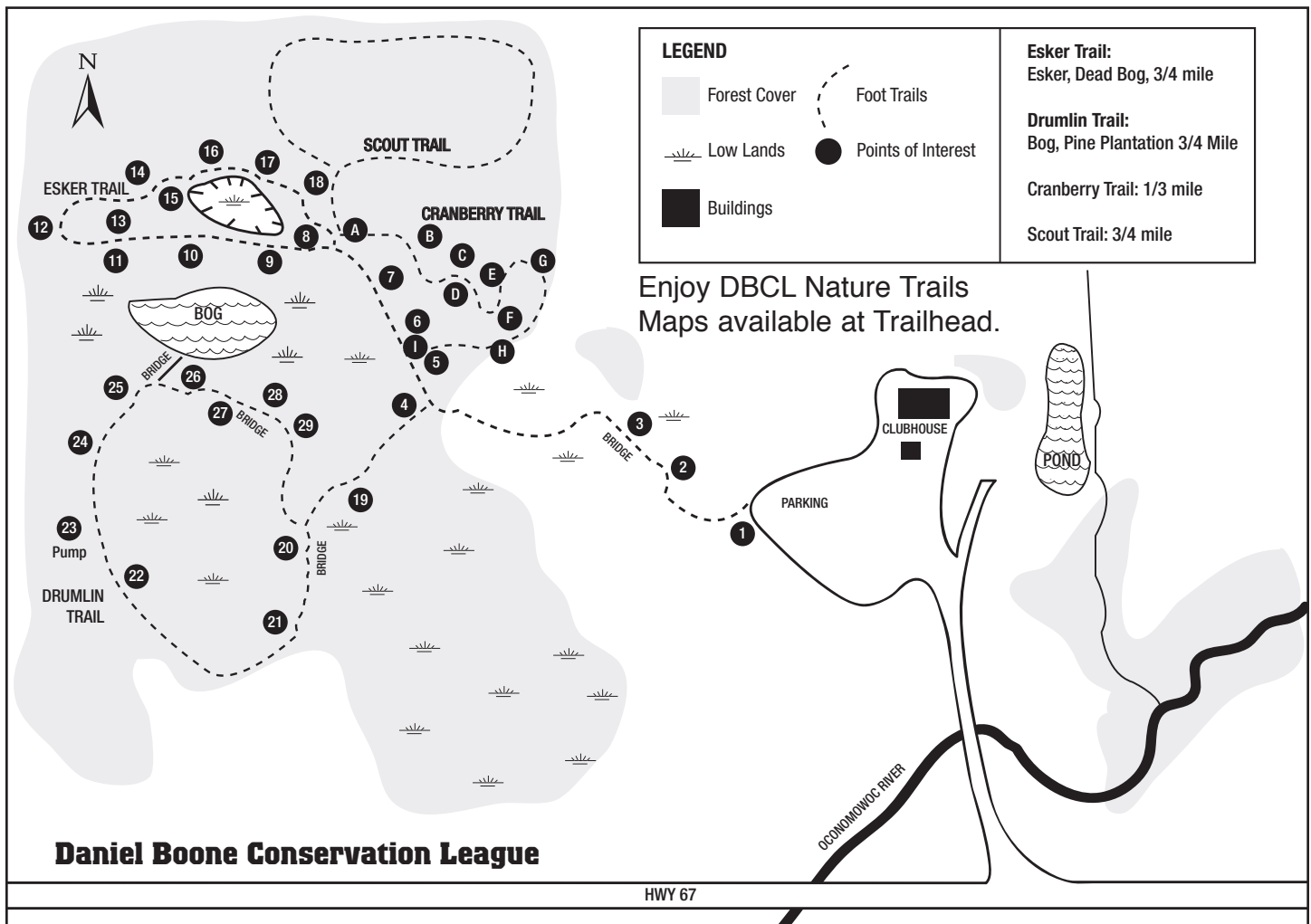
