Pellet Pistol & Rifle League *Tom Stencel*

The Pellet Pistol and Rifle Leagues will hold an informational gathering on **Tuesday, November 29th from 6:00 – 9:00 pm** in the lower level of our clubhouse.

The previous league members will have the opportunity to either practice or shoot ahead. Due to time limits, we will NOT shoot any benchrest rifle competition. Interested new league members will be shown our new pellet pistols and will learn how our leagues are conducted.

The Pistol League consists of two persons per team. We use a 95% handicap system for scoring; therefore, a shooter DOES NOT have to be an expert marksman to participate. All pistol shooting is done offhand using a one or two hand hold. Scopes are permitted.

The formal leagues will start on Saturday, December 3rd, (Pistol and Benchrest Rifle), and will continue for 12 weeks. Benchrest Rifle competition will start at noon and end at 2:00 pm. The Rifle League will also run for 12 weeks. The fee for EACH league (Pistol or Rifle) will be \$36. Targets will be provided at no cost. League fees must be paid NO LATER than December 17th.

I am looking forward to seeing all the previous league members and hopefully, a good number of new participants.

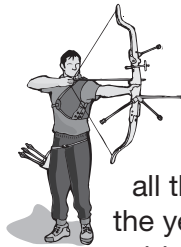
Trap and Skeet *Hank Golner*

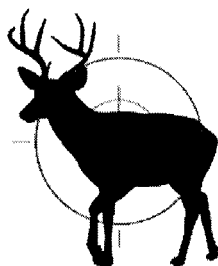

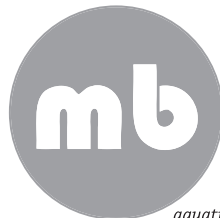
