It's finally cooled off and many grown people are sitting in trees like apes trying to ambush deer. Most of the summer projects at DBCL are completed.

The short range is FINALLY operational and should provide needed range space for those practicing with handguns. PLEASE NOTE: There is no bell at this range yet. SHOOTERS - USE COMMON SENSE AND TALK WITH EACH OTHER WHEN HEADING DOWN RANGE TO CHANGE TARGETS. This range is only 12 yards to the far target bank - YOU CAN SEE IF SOMEONE IS AHEAD OF THE LINE. Thanks to ALL the volunteers, donors and contractors for getting this project done and the members for being patient.

The contract for the drainage repair on the east side of the clubhouse has been awarded. This will allow us to repair the damage to the drywall downstairs with no further leakage from the outside.

The Board is recommending to the body to acquire a 9 to 10 foot snow plow and chains for the Skid Steer for up to \$3,800. This will allow us to do MOST of our plowing without bringing in outside help.

The repair to the tenant's barn and lean to from the windstorm of this summer is finally underway. The majority of this cost was covered by our insurance.

It was decided that the unending goose poop issue would only be solved by eliminating the source. The Board assigned several qualified individuals with the proper DNR goose permits to remove the issues.

Dan and Judy Bingen have signed a 1 year contract extension to remain as our caretakers. We all appreciate the way in which they maintain the grounds and are very pleased that they will stay with us.

We voted to adopt Boy Scout Troop 110. They have

helped us for years and they were forced to vacate the space in which they held their meetings. It seemed like the right way to help.

The Board voted again to hold off on allowing any concealed carry or outside handgun training courses in the clubhouse or on the ranges at this time.

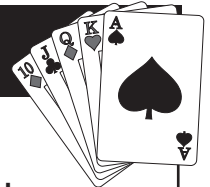

Gallery League *Steve Draeger*

The Gallery season is upon us. This league is open to anyone interested in competing in 4-position rifle matches using a .22 cal. rimfire target rifle. A typical match consists of 40 record shots (10 record shots from each position: prone, kneeling, sitting and standing) with unlimited sighters. The matches are held indoors with targets set at a distance of 50 feet. Gallery provides an opportunity to shoot indoors throughout the winter season.

League shooting will start on Thursday, October 13th and will continue each consecutive Thursday through November 10, 2011. A short break for Thanksgiving will occur with the league resuming on Thursday, December 1, 2011. There will be the opportunity for preseason practice, which will occur the week of October 2nd. The evenings of Tuesday, October 4th, Wednesday, October 5th, and Thursday, October 6th are being considered for practice dates. Since the practice dates and times are tentative, please check with me prior to October 4th for exact dates and times.

The range opens at approximately 6:30 p.m. for practice. On league nights, the first relay begins at approximately 7:30 p.m. The Waukesha range, which also serves as our homebase, is located in the Hillcrest Park at 2119 Davidson Road, Waukesha, Wisconsin.
