Short Range Construction and Use

The new short range is nearing completion. Major efforts by Troy Mews, Jim Pfantz, Darryl Voss, your President and many volunteers on 2 different workdays should give us a user friendly and safer alternative for short range and self-defense handgun use. The Board has decreed that THERE WILL BE NO METALLIC TARGETS (Dingers) used on this range period. They should be used on the 2 bumps on the sides of the 50 meter range and against the silhouette berms on the 200 ONLY. Thanks to all those that came out on the workdays to make this range useable. It is noteworthy that the 50 meter range was only closed 11 full days and the 200 yard range was only closed 7 full days during this construction. Thanks for your understanding. It was nice to see Ken Shotton step up and volunteer to head the range Safety Baffling effort. While some even question it's merits, 99% of us realize that safety must come first and realize that without a long range safety plan, we could be vulnerable like other shooting clubs have been. Thanks for the help, Ken.

Emergency workdays and Repairs

We had 2 emergency workdays to help finish tasks on the ranges. The Trap Range was mowed, Proper drainage on trap #1, the short range and rerouting of same on the 200 firing line was done. Washouts were repaired on the Scout Ground road, our tenants driveway and on the 200 yard pit road. Electric was repaired on the 200, the running deer, the short range and on the 50. Minor repairs were also done on the clubhouse. The target shack was finished. The major drainage repair is scheduled for the east side of the clubhouse so the drywall repairs can be done in the lower level. Thanks to all the volunteers and contractors that handled this. Overall with the new Skid Steer, the range work and the repairs, we have spent over \$70,000 of your money but we will

be way better off when the tasks are done. At least we had the money to do it – unlike the Federal Government.

Fall Events

The summer Leagues are behind us now. The Fall brings us Fall Trap, the SWRA Gallery Rifle League, Hunting on the Grounds, more urgent use of the ranges to warm up for the hunting seasons and in 2 months, our 2011 SIGHT IN CLINIC and more. I hope the members turn out in full force for the sight in clinic work day on September 10th and on the 7 days of the sight in clinic. New Chairman Tom Secora needs your help if we are to make this public service event a success.

For those who normally participate in the tactical challenge matches and may not have a handgun or a shotgun, but would like to try a match using more than just your carbine, we will have guns available for you to use.

For those who wish to shoot our more traditional tactical match, you will have the option to shoot a standard, yet challenging course and you will need a minimum of 35 rounds of ammo.

We hope to see all the usual guys as well as some new faces out at the last match of the year. The match will run from 9:00am – 2:00pm.

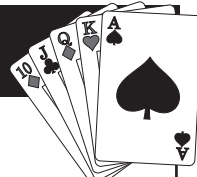
