Important Safety Concern – Please disarm trap machines before entering the trap house. There have been times when we have entered the houses and they are still armed – this can be a very painful experience for the next person to go in front of the house if it accidentally trips and sends out a bird.

Summer leagues are well underway. Even if you weren't able to join a team and shoot in the league, you can still come out and shoot a practice round from 5:00 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. either Wednesday or Thursday night. Last squad out at 8:15 pm.

Trap Doubles – Looking for something new and exciting to try? Join our new 24 bird trap doubles league. This individual league will be in conjunction with the regular trap season and will be a 10 week league starting June 15. Cost will be \$5 for members and \$7 for non-members with a \$5 registration fee per person.

Practice All Year – All members can be checked out on our equipment. This can be done on trap and skeet nights or by appointment. 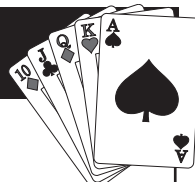
