Rules for Scouting Area Use

All request for reservations are to be made well in advance through the Daniel Boone Scouting Chairman. Council tour permits are required. (No Exceptions.)

Scouts must pre-pay & register for approval to use Scout grounds. Please see application for costs.

General rules:

- a) Bring your own wood.
- b) Haul-away your trash and garbage.
- c) You may use left-over wood, if any, from the ax yard wood pile.
- d) No logging, no alcohol, no fire works, no firearms.
- e) Before you leave, rinse out portable toilet with hot soapy water please. Leave everything nice for the next users.
- f) Keep the area by the water pump (north of eating area) clean.
- g) Pour dirty-soapy water into a sump hole well back in woods.
- h) If your troop is large, arrange with DBCL for extra porta-johns.
- i) Fires in designated fire areas only, attended or out.
- j) Please remove trash or excessive ash from fire area.
- k) Check-in with caretaker noon – 6pm Friday or 8-12 am Saturday 262-628-1328, or at house near parking off main entrance to club.
- l) If you use stacked poles for lashings or lean-to's, re-stack them.

Scout rules:

- a) Keep to nature trails and Scout area. Respect our natural areas.
- b) Club house and shooting areas off limits.
- c) If your troop is large, arrange with us for extra porta-johns.
- d) Clear all special activities with scout director.
- e) Park cars at club parking lot, not Scout grounds after drop -off.
- f) No cars in Scout area. Use trail to Scout grounds from south end of the 50 meter range. Bear left twice on trail. It's a short walk.
- g) Consider using Scout grounds for your courts of honor or including Eagle court of honor
